WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS POINTS

Global: The nation of Israel and surrounding nations and peoples. Pray for the peace of the Lord to be known among the Israelis and the Palestinians especially, but all the people of the region, including the residents of Jordan, Syria, and Lebanon. Pray that Jesus the Nazarene, the Christ of God, might be known as Lord among the people.

Domestic: Law enforcement agencies and personnel to carry out their purpose with dignity and justice. That they might find the meaning in their vocation, not in the clamor of detractors, but in the honor of the privilege to serve and protect. For departments in search of personnel to find honorable, courageous, qualified candidates.

Parachurch: Missionary organizations. Pray for effective recruiting, equipping, sending, and supporting of missionaries. Pray also for the ministry to flow from the relationship to the local church.

Ecclesial: Global missionary efforts within the church. Pray that the church would cultivate and send missionaries in the apostolic manner of the early church.

Unreached People Group: The Brahmin of India (with smaller groups in Pakistan, Nepal, Bhutan, and Bangladesh). The Brahmin traditionally identified as the most exalted of the Hindu castes. The name relates to the Hindu concept of divinity and attaining to the supreme notion of existence. They number over 60M.
