WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS POINTS

Global: The impoverished, orphaned, widowed, or oppressed. That God will execute justice, give food, set the oppressed free, support the fatherless, loosen the bonds of wickedness, break every yoke of bondage, and do such through his people (see Psalm 146:7–9, Isaiah 58:6–7).

Domestic: For professional athletes. For the Christians among them to remain steadfast in the grace of the gospel, and use their influence profitably. For those who remain apart from Christ, to repent and turn to the Lord in faith.

Parachurch: Sports Ministries (e.g., Upward, FCA)

Ecclesial: For Iglesia Esmirna Lima Sur and all the “Esmirna” churches in Peru (even all local churches in Peru). Pray for continued emboldened witness, God’s favor upon their people, every provision, and faithfulness to the gospel and Apostolic teaching among the pastors and elders. Pray for the Lima Sur mission trip to the jungle regions at the end of June.

Unreached People Group: The residents of the Pamplona and Puente Piedra districts/neighborhoods in Lima, Peru. The residents in these neighborhoods are among the most impoverished in Lima (with a population over 10M). Often neglected both physically and spiritually, the people of these districts need the witness of the church, and the grace of the gospel.

Discipleship Practice: Rejoicing in Salvation (see Psalm 13:5 and Luke 15)
