WEEKLY PRAYER AND REFLECTION

This week **prayerfully reflect** on and **rejoice** knowing... **God comforts those who mourn.**

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." Jesus' words here from Matthew 5:4, are a reminder of a sure hope in the midst of tragedy and loss.
