PERU MISSION TRIP

THIS WEEK

TODAY, 11:45–12:00: Baptism at Newport Park. After dismissal from service, head to Newport Park to witness the baptism of Lanita Burgess.

TUESDAY, OCT. 12, 5:30–7:00: Meal and Sermon Discussion at Bernander home. Join us to eat a meal together as Pastor Aaron leads a discussion from the preaching passage and readings from Sunday. We will delve into questions and discuss how to personally apply the Scriptures in our lives. This group plans to meet roughly every other week.
